


New Adult Official 3-Person Crew – Pre-Game (NCAA Rules)

<p><b>SUCCESS KEYS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>SAO</b> – Safety, Advantage/Disadvantage/Obvious</li> <li>▪ Be in position</li> <li>▪ Don't ball watch</li> <li>▪ Blow the whistle loud, throw the flag high</li> </ul>		<p><b>FACEOFFS</b> (<i>Top to stop, parallel to line, ball in center, clear neutral zone</i>)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Mechanic</b> – Down, [adjust sticks] place ball, “set”, [back out] whistle</li> <li>▪ <b>Faceoff Official</b> – Back out to single side</li> <li>▪ <b>Lead Left (Helper)</b> – Be aware of the wings, call violations if you see them</li> <li>▪ <b>Wing Official</b> – Stop sign until field is set, when ready then point</li> <li>▪ <b>Violation</b> – No play-on! Single restarts</li> <li>▪ <b>Count</b> – Single has the 30-second count upon possession</li> </ul>	
<p><b>DEFINITIONS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Possession</b> – Carry, cradle, pass, shoot</li> <li>▪ <b>Goal</b> – Loose ball that completely crosses the rear edge of the goal line</li> <li>▪ <b>Out of bounds</b> – Loose ball/player in possession touches the line</li> <li>▪ <b>Shot out of bounds</b> – Ball awarded to team with closest in-bounds player's body (not crosse) to the ball <u>when</u> and <u>where</u> it went out</li> <li>▪ <b>Offside</b> – More than 6 on offense or 7 on defense; count forward</li> </ul>		<p><b>TABLE</b> (<i>Timer and scorer are part of the officiating team</i>)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Penalties</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 5-min of personal fouls = disqualification</li> <li>○ No release during faceoff until “possession”</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ <b>Timekeeper</b> – start and stop clock on whistle</li> <li>▪ Blow horn at the end of period/shot clock</li> </ul>	
<p><b>LEAD OFFICIAL</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Position</b> – Step above or below GLE</li> <li>▪ <b>Transition</b> – Stay one line ahead of the ball</li> <li>▪ <b>Coverage</b> – Two-man game until Trail gets in</li> <li>▪ <b>End Line</b> – On or near line for contested plays</li> <li>▪ <b>Goals</b> – Check with Single, watch bodies</li> </ul>	<p><b>TRAIL OFFICIAL</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Position</b> – At the top of the box</li> <li>▪ <b>Transition</b> – Stays behind the ball</li> <li>▪ <b>On Shots</b> – Shooter!</li> <li>▪ <b>Far Goal</b> – You are the Lead</li> <li>▪ <b>Offside</b> – Count O, then D</li> </ul>	<p><b>SINGLE-SIDE OFFICIAL</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Position</b> – At the top of the crease</li> <li>▪ <b>Transition</b> – Gets to the far cone</li> <li>▪ <b>On Shots</b> – Shooter!</li> <li>▪ <b>GLE</b> – Cover goal if Lead drops below</li> <li>▪ <b>Offside</b> – Count O, then D</li> </ul>	
<p><b>CHECK THE FIELD</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Field</b> – Lines are clearly marked and the field is safe</li> <li>▪ <b>Balls</b> – Have NOCSAE stamp (4 balls on the sidelines and end lines)</li> <li>▪ <b>Goals</b> – No holes in the net or balls in the back of them</li> </ul>	<p><b>CREASE PLAY</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Ball Toward You</b> – Watch feet</li> <li>▪ <b>Ball Away from You</b> – Watch body</li> <li>▪ <b>Dive/Jump</b> – Can never score if player lands in crease</li> </ul>		
<p><b>COMMUNICATION</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Echo</b> – Flag down, Possession, Shot Clock, Tip</li> <li>▪ <b>Mimic</b> – Stop &amp; ready signals, Shot clock, touched in box, possession</li> <li>▪ <b>Penalties</b> – Relay to crew, Trail reports to table, partner sets field</li> <li>▪ <b>Be Aware</b> – Know the game you are working &amp; how it is changing</li> </ul>	<p><b>EQUIPMENT INSPECTIONS</b> (<i>Minimum of 6</i>)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Where</b> – Midline; two officials face in, one faces out</li> <li>▪ <b>When</b> – Timeouts and quarter breaks (adjust as needed)</li> <li>▪ <b>Who</b> – Grab the bench you are closest to; Single gets ball</li> <li>▪ <b>Fix It Tickets</b> – Incorrect butt end, hanging strings past 2”</li> </ul>		
<p><b>TIME OUTS</b> (<i>Called by head coach or field player</i>)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Called When</b> – In possession, dead ball when not the defensive team following a turnover in the field of play.</li> <li>▪ <b>Timer On</b> – 1:40 seconds + 20 seconds to restart = 2 min total</li> <li>▪ <b>Reassess</b> – Confirm score with partner, timeouts remaining, AP</li> <li>▪ <b>Discuss</b> – How is the game going? Any adjustments we need to make?</li> </ul>	<p><b>WHEN TO THROW A FLAG</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ <b>Flag</b> – Throw high, yell “flag down,” eyes stay on players</li> <li>▪ <b>Personal</b> – Always results in a flag down</li> <li>▪ <b>Personal While Loose</b> – Immediate whistle + flag down</li> <li>▪ <b>Technical</b> – Turnover or a 30-second penalty</li> <li>▪ <b>GOODIE</b> – Know when to end a flag down slow whistle</li> </ul>		

New Adult Official 2-Person Crew – Pre-Game (NCAA Rules)

<p>Shot Clock!</p>	<p><b>SHOT CLOCK (Visible)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Crew agrees to put the stall on</li> <li>Everyone signals and says “Shot Clock!”</li> <li>Clock begins to count down</li> <li>If clock does not start, stop play unless there is an imminent scoring opportunity and reset to 25.</li> </ul>	<p><b>SHOT CLOCK (Off the Game Clock)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Must start on an increment of 10</li> <li>Everyone signals and says “Shot Clock!”</li> <li>Say when it’s over – “at 4:30!”</li> <li>If clock does not start, stop play unless there is an imminent scoring opportunity and reset to 25.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Shot</b> = Hits pipe, goalkeeper, or a goal is scored. Shot must be above GLE</p>		
		<p><b>GOODIE (when to end a flag down, slow whistle)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Goal is scored</li> <li>Offense commits a penalty</li> <li>Out of bounds</li> <li>Defense gains possession</li> <li>Injury in the scrimmage area</li> <li>End of the period or the game</li> </ul>
<p><b>'17-'18 NCAA POINTS OF EMPHASIS</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Stall Warning/Shot Clock</li> <li>Use of the Head</li> <li>Faceoffs             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Grabbing sticks or ball = USC</li> </ul> </li> </ol>	<p><b>GAME MANAGEMENT – BASICS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Respond to questions, not statements</li> <li>Be brief and factual at all times</li> </ul> <p><b>FIGHT MECHANICS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Closest Official</b> – Loud whistles, move around bodies, keep blowing the whistle!</li> <li><b>Furthest Official</b> – Freeze benches, get numbers</li> </ul>	<p><b>GAME MANAGEMENT – HELPFUL PHRASES</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>“Coach, I want to work together.”</li> <li>“I understand that; I appreciate that, but here is what I saw on that play...”</li> <li>“I need you to rein in your assistant before he puts you man down.”</li> </ul>
<p><b>FINAL CHECKLIST</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Whistles, flags, timers, scorecards, coins, measuring tape</li> <li>Do our uniforms match?</li> <li>Remember we have to call the <b>ROUC!</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>ROUGH, OBVIOUS, UNNECESSARY, CHEAP</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>WHEN THE BALL IS DEAD WE BECOME ALIVE!</b></p>	<p><b>PENALTY REPORTING (C-NOTE)</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Color, Number, Offense, Time, Explanation [as needed]</li> <li>Blue, 27, Slash, 1-minute</li> <li>White, 14, Push, 30-seconds [give the “T” signal]</li> <li>Dead ball, Blue, 36, Unsportsmanlike Conduct, 1-minute, nonreleasable, White ball at Center X.</li> </ul>
